









Satisfy your longing for long-range views at the "StubaiBlick"

The Panoramaweg trail leads to the viewing platform at 2,160 m. It features three impressive footbridges each oriented towards a legendary mountain

Around the Kreuzjoch mountain

the Kreuzjoch mountain, offering impressive panoramic views of the Kalkkögel mountains and the Stubaital valley. If, on the other hand, your goal is the summit of the Kreuzjoch mountain, the direct ascent takes about 60 minutes via the summit circular hiking trail (route no. 1).

his climbing park offers a variety of options. We recommend that beginners are accompanied by a mountain guide. Appropriate equipment, a good head for heights and sure-footedness are prerequisites for use. The zip lines may only be used with a mountain guide!

HIKES FROM THE KREUZJOCH MOUNTAIN STATION

This hike leads from the Froneben middle station to the larch meadows where a viewing platform provides panoramic views of the Serles, Elfer & Habicht mountains and the Pinnistal valley. Return via the Vergör mountain hut to the Schlick 2000 valley station.

The Gletscherblick nature viewpoint: enjoy priceless views

The Gletscherblick nature viewpoint boasts one of the very best views in all of the Stubaital valley. Coming from the Kreuzjoch mountain station, continue towards the Starkenburger Hütte mountain hut (route no. 3) to arrive at the viewpoint after 90 min.



Meanwhile, the flight school offers a wide range of courses.



No new flights may be flown if a general flight ban is imposed (e.g. due to bad weather conditions, helicopter approach, etc.). nutes via the Brenner motorway (Europabrücke) > Schönberg exit. Schönberg is the first village of the Stubai valley - continue on to Mieders, Telfes, Fulpmes and Neustift. Or drive toll-free along the old Brenner road to Schönberg (approx. 35 min. drive). Via train plane or bus to Innshruck From Innshruck main station, there is a direct bus line to the Stubaital valley (to Neustift/Mutterberg). Buses run daily, Timetable available at stubai at.
